ABOUT ABC INTERVENTION

ABC Intervention was developed by Mary Dozier at University of Delaware, USA. Through randomised

clinical trials, ABC has been shown to be an effective home visiting program for infants and toddlers (6-24 months of age) living with their birth, foster or adoptive parents. The program is endorsed by key organisations in the US, e.g. The California Evidence-Based Clearing House for Child Welfare. EIRD (The Early Intervention Research Directorate) in South Australia recognises ABC as an Evidence Based Intervention in working with high risk infants and vulnerable families.

Findings from the clinical trials have shown that ABC enhances attachment security, normalises the production of cortisol, and improves language abilities, impulse control and other skills important to school readiness

ABC is a 10 week home visiting intervention for birth, foster or adoptive parents of infants between 6-24 months of age. ABC helps caregivers learn optimal sensitive parenting behaviour which in turn assists the child in emotion regulation. It is designed to assist parents in following their child's lead and creating nurturing environments and to avoid frightening their children.

THE TRAINING

INITIAL TRAINING in ABC takes place in-person and lasts for 2 days. This initial training includes theoretical and practical orientation to the intervention, practice with "In the Moment" commenting and coding, review of session content, consultation concerning site-specific implementation, and planning for the supervision year.

SUPERVISION: Ongoing Supervision is the primary source of the training.

Supervision is conducted via a web-based platform.

Trainees have 2 supervision meetings per week: General Clinical Supervision (1 hour, with a small group) and In the Moment Commenting Supervision (30 minutes, individual). The time commitment for session preparation, homevisit, and supervision is approximately 4 hours per case each week.

Parent coaches are asked to complete a minimum of 3 ABC cases throughout the course of the training year.

SCREENING PROCESS: There is a screening process for parent coaches because there are aspects of the intervention that have found to be challenging for some parent coaches. A half-hour screening to predict which coaches are going to likely succeed with ABC will be done once registrations have been received. This will be done remotely through video conferencing with the trainers at University of Delaware. There are no prerequisite qualifications for parent coaches.
