Neonatal Behavioural Assessment Scale NBAS Training – May 2019

Date: May 4th and 5th, Saturday 10-4 and Sunday 9-3

Venue: Wesley Hospital, 91 Milton Rd Ashfield, Education Centre, Seminar Rm 3

Training cost: \$550 in total: \$110 payable as a deposit, to secure your place **now**, \$110 payable on the **first day** of the training (4th May) and \$330 payable when you have your **final assessment** (this will be organised when you have performed at least 20 practice assessments on live babies).

Requirements:

1. You can buy the training manual, around US\$50.00 + postage, from Amazon. Com (this comes to around AU\$83.00)

The Neonatal Behavioural Assessment Scale Manual, 4th Ed., 2011 (Hardcover). Completely revised in 2011, the manual describes the Scale, its development, administration and scoring, research and clinical uses.

You can buy it now for AU\$70.00 + postage. 4 copies still available.

AND

Try to get the just the manual, or the Handbook as well, as soon as possible, as it is essential to read thoroughly before the training weekend, to have a rough understanding of the process and lots of questions.

2. You will need to purchase a life-size baby doll to practice on (see below). It should have a floppy body and limbs, to be more realistic, and the plastic parts should be as soft as possible, also for realism. You will need this for the weekend in April. You can find realistic silicone 22" dolls on eBay for around \$75

3. From the manual, you will see that you need some accessories to do the assessment. You can purchase these from any source but the full kits are available from the Brazelton Institute and can be ordered online. I may be ordering more this year and collecting them in June for the October training.
